We are committed to providing a friendly and welcoming space, designed with our students in mind. Special features include a library, music room, computer lab, gymnasium, and a safe outdoor play area.


At CMS, learning is tailored for each child. Our innovative approach and small class sizes prepare students for all aspects of life.
